The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Marc Lindeen, Vice-Chairman, Greg Moeller and Gary See.

Joining the meeting was Ted Mohrfeld, Randy Wilkerson, Linda Johnson, Richard Johnson.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the minutes of the April 6, 2017 meeting. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

John Pullis, Conservation gave his monthly update to the Board. The campgrounds will be opening Friday April 14, 2017, Gibson Recreation Areas CRP ground need reenrolled and they have put part in a Quail Initiative Program where they seed 40% in short grass mix and create a 1 acre area of bushes for a covey headquarters and they will receive payment similar as when it was in CRP. Conservation Board approved Warner Engineering contract to move Water Works Campground to higher grounds and do a feasibility study.

Teresa Hills, Mandi Mullin, Kim Fenton and Robyn Buffington of the Imagine Recreating Mt Union Committee a non-profit 501c3 presented a letter to the Supervisors explaining how the Eagle's Landing Park in the former city of Mt. Union came to be and asked for the county's support in saving their park. There were approximately 12 other individuals there in support of the park. Dennis Krieger & his brother Miles was among them and stated they had donated \$28,000 to build the gazebo in memory of their parents who have passed away but had lived their whole life in Mt. Union and asked for the Supervisors help. Randy Wilkerson a former council member of Mt Union stated he had made a motion at the November 2016 council meeting to sell all remaining property owned by the city in December and January it was seconded and voted on unanimously to approve the motion. At the December meeting, Mr. Wilkerson asked the Mayor of the status on the sale of city property. The Mayor stated that the realtors advised not to sell now. Mr. Wilkerson called Steffes Group and asked why they recommended not to sell, he was told no one had contacted them about selling. The Board of Supervisors told the group that the county has no say in the matter now it is under the control of the Iowa State City Development Board until at least September 23, 2017.

In other county business, the Board reviewed the Recorder's Quarterly Report ending 3/31/17.

No sub-committee meetings.

It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See the meeting be adjourned. 3 ayes. Motion carried.
