The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Marc Lindeen, Greg Moeller and Gary See.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the minutes of the August 3, 2017 Supervisors meeting. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer, accompanied by Jelen McCall, office Manager gave the Secondary Road update. Road maintenance July 31<sup>st</sup> thru August 4<sup>th</sup>. Territory operators were in their blades and checking dust control, continued spraying roadsides for weeds and mowing shoulders. Continued concrete patching on Salem Rd, continued shoulder pulling project on Marsh Ave and hauled rock to Marsh Ave in anticipation of rain forecasted Wednesday night. Worked on road signs and on a ditching project on James Ave. Closed Merrimac Rd and removed old sealcoat and asphalt just west of Franklin Ave then hauled rock to it. Winfield Ave from Iris St to the west to Grand Ave is closed to through traffic, contractor has started working on placing modified subbase from Grand Ave to Detrick's Truck & Trailer Service. Contractor plans to pour another section later this week or early next week. Subcontractor will be closing Winfield Ave east of Iris St starting Thursday morning; the intersection will remain open for businesses west of Iris St. A detour will be set up for Winfield Ave from 220<sup>th</sup> St then south on Marsh Ave to Hwy 34. The Engineer wants to remind the public that Pilot is entered from Grand Ave and Detrick's Truck & Trailer Service, Liquid-grow, Mini Storage, Pioneer Seeds and East End Automotive are all open for business and have access off Iris St. Oakland Mills Bridge repair work, with Dormark Construction Co continues to have the Bridge over the Skunk River on W55 closed. Contractor will be pouring approaches Wednesday or Thursday. The contractor plans to be completed with enough of the work to open the bridge to traffic by Friday night or Saturday. County crew continues shoulder pull on Marsh Ave from Hwy 34 going south to the intersection of Logan Ave, we are now working on the last mile. Merrimac Rd directly west of Trenton work has been completed and contractor will be in 3 to 4 weeks to resurface the section rebuilt.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the Certification of the Canvass of votes of the Special Election August 1, 2017 for Bond Referendum of 9.1 million dollars to construct a new Law Center/Jail for Henry County. 3 ayes. Motion carried. The votes were as follows:  
3065 votes cast; 2595 Yes votes; 468 No votes; 2 Blank votes; with an 84.7% approval.

No sub-committee meetings.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller the meeting be adjourned. 3 ayes. Motion carried.
